

COMMUNITY IMPACT REPORT

This report shares the successes with you - our volunteers, donors, homeowners, corporate partners, faith communities, civic and service organizations - helped us achieve.

In fiscal year 2021, Habitat for Humanity of York County carried out its neighborhood revitalization model through a spectrum of housing solutions, community engagement, financial capability and homeowner services.

VOLUNTEERS

A total of volunteers 295 volunteers gave 5,613
 hours of volunteer service. According to the
 Independent Sector the value of volunteer time
 is \$29.95 per hour. This volunteer contribution
 represents a total value of more than \$165,000.





COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Through a partnership with Affinity Health Center, **6** neighborhood-based COVID vaccination clinics were conducted—**2** Clover, **2** in York and **2** in Rock Hill. These clinics resulted in **1,300** vaccinations administered.

The organization collaborated in a county-wide Thanksgiving food distribution project serving **150** households and Habitat homebuyers-in-process contributed **7,900** items to a local soup kitchen as a component of their sweat equity requirement.

The affiliate also collaborated in **2** community planning initiatives with the Crawford Road Neighborhood of Rock Hill which supported the Clinton Connextion Action Plan.







HOMEOWNERSHIP

Through the Homeownership Program, the affiliate completed **two new construction homes** in Rock Hill resulting in affordable homeownership with two families (2 adults and 2 children). Each home was constructed using energy efficient practices. Construction was in process on **two additional new homes** in Rock Hill by the end of the fiscal year with two families (2 adults and 7 children). During the fiscal year, there were a total of **17 homebuyer-in-process families** (representing 19 adults and 42 children) in the Homeownership Program.





HOMEBUYER SERVICES

46 participants attended homebuyer orientation sessions and **752** individuals completed pre- homeownership/financial literacy sessions. The affiliate also serviced a total of **53** no-interest mortgages

CRITICAL HOME REPAIR

Through the Home Repair Program, the organization completed a total of **30** critical home repair projects (including three veterans) serving primarily senior citizens and/or disabled homeowners. **13** critical home repair projects were in process at the end of the fiscal year. Home repair projects were completed in Clover/Lake Wylie, Fort Mill, Rock Hill, and York.
