FY2022 ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS

Habitat for Humanity of York County

FY2022 (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022)

An economic impact analysis for FY2022 (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022) conducted by Habitat for Humanity South Carolina reported the following outcomes for the work of **Habitat for Humanity of York County**:

- **\$2,573,249** was invested in the economy by the affiliate's work over the past year;
- **21** staff members were directly employed;
- Affiliate's investment created **\$3,889,836** of total economic activity:
 - supporting **29** total jobs and
 - paying **\$1,437,436** in labor income.
- For every dollar invested by the affiliate, an additional **66 cents** were injected into the local economy, amounting to a return on investment of **\$1.66**.

In 2022, the Habitat team in South Carolina invested over \$40 million, helping families across the Palmetto State as they achieved their goal of attainable, safe, and healthy homeownership. Habitat's investment created nearly \$62 million of total economic activity, supporting 516 total jobs, and paying \$21.4 million in labor income throughout South Carolina.
